Founded in 2008, OBAT Primary School in Sardar Bahadur Nagar, Khulshi, Chattogram, offers grades KG-5 to children from nearby camps. As OBAT's first and one of its largest schools, it provides quality education that was once a privilege for the wealthy, opening opportunities for camp residents.
